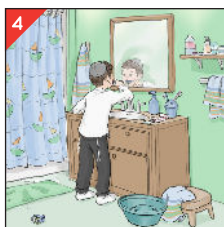

It's from the library and he doesn't want to forget what page he's up to; what should he do? It's the day of the Siyum and Eliyahu doesn't feel well enough to go to school, what should he do? Why is it important not to go to school if you're not feeling well? What can he do to prevent the spreading of germs to other children in his class? ² The library book fell into his Negel Vasser and now it is all wet; what should he do? Eliyahu overslept and it is now 8:00, and he missed his bus; what should he do? ² His foot kicked the bucket, and the water spilled all over the rug; what should he do? He forgot to prepare a towel before he washed his hands, and now his hands are all wet; what should he do? ³ He arrived at school and realized that he left his watch on the bathroom floor. He wants his watch so he will know how much more time he has until recess; what should he do? ⁴ The boy is buttoning his shirt and he buttoned it all wrong; what should he do? The boy is buttoning his shirt when he realized that he is missing a button; what should he do? ⁴ He wants to look in the mirror to see if his face is clean, but it's all fogged up and he can't see himself; what should he do? ⁵ He got to school and realized that he forgot to sign his test. His teacher gives out a prize if the tests are returned signed. He wants a prize; what should he do? ⁵ The boy wants to drink orange juice for breakfast. He doesn't like the taste of orange juice after toothpaste. He just brushed his teeth; what should he do? ⁶ Eliyahu got to school and realized that he left his cookies for the Siyum at home. His mother is at work; what should he do? He brought cookies for the siyum but didn't realize that a boy in his class is allergic to the cookies; what should he do?

Question Prompts: **1)** Who is sleeping? What time is it? What month is it? What time will the boy wake up? Where did he put his Yarmulka? Did he take of his yarmulke before or after he read the book? What kind of collection does he have? What is he wearing to go to bed? What did he prepare for the morning? What is his name? How is the boy feeling? What book did the boy read in his bed before he went to sleep? What will he wear tomorrow? Why will he wear a white shirt tomorrow? Eliyahu is having a Siyum tomorrow, what else might he and his classmates have done to prepare for the special day? Why are there tissues on the floor? Where was Eliyahu standing when he took his shoes off?

2) What is Eliyahu doing? What will he do next? What is his mother saying? What time is it? Where is the book? How did the book get on the floor? What will he do next? What did he do before he washed his hands? When did he put his Yarmulka on? What will he use to dry his hands? What is he saying? What is he wearing? Why would he need to wear slippers? Will he wear a coat to school today?

3) How is Eliyahu feeling? How do you know he is happy? Why might he be feeling happy? How long did it take him to get dressed? Where might his mother be now? What did he put on before he put his shirt on? What will he put on next? Where are his pajamas? Where should he put his pajamas?

4) Where is Eliyahu? What is he doing? What time is it? Did someone take a shower in the morning? How do you know? Why did he bring the Negel Vassar to the bathroom? What is the problem with the towel? How much toothpaste is left? Where will the boy put the empty tube of toothpaste?

5) What time is it? What did Eliyahu do after he brushed his teeth? When did he solve the Rubix cube? At least how long did it take him to solve the Rubix cube? What is his mother drinking? How can you tell that it's hot? What is the weather outside? Did anyone go outside yet? Who may have taken a shower? Is the milk carton empty? What will Eliyahu be bringing to school for the siyum? What is the mother looking at? What might she be thinking? Did Eliyahu do well on his test?

6) Where is Eliyahu going? What is the name of the street the Gold Family lives on? What is their address? Was the mail picked up yet today? What number bus is Eliyahu on? Is he the first to get on the bus?
