Students will read about cleaning for Pesach and finding Chametz.


Materials Needed:


- Coloring supplies
- Stapler or coil binding

Instructions:

- 1. Print either just one book for the classroom or a book for each student.
- 2. If each student is receiving his/her own book, have students color-in the pictures, otherwise color-in the pictures yourself.
- 3. Bind the books using staples or binding.
- 4. Read the book out loud. Ask students to share if they have found any Chametz and if so, what type of Chametz they found and where they found it.


WHERE WILL I FIND CHOMETZ?

In many corners, there were some traces.




I opened the toy chest



It smelled so bad, I started to gag!




I took the long hose \ vacuumed

Corn flakes, cheerios \ so much more,


Were all piled up on the floor!

from almost every car ride.




We cleaned the attic and the basement too,


We did all that we had to do.
