- Chrein/prepared horseradish (refrigerate separately in a sealed plastic bag)
- Coconut aminos, "soy sauce" substitute
- Jam (apricot, raspberry, strawberry, etc.)
- Ketchup, mayonnaise
- Maple syrup (pure)
- Marinara
- Marsala cooking wine
- Sauces: BBQ, cranberry (whole & jellied), duck
- Vinegars: balsamic, imitation, red wine

DRIED SPICES & SEASONINGS

- Basics: black pepper (*fine, whole, coarse*), garlic powder, onion powder, paprika, salt (*coarse, fine sea, kosher*), white pepper
- Cinnamon (*ground, sticks*)
- Dried herbs: basil, bay leaves, dill, mint, oregano, parsley, rosemary, thyme
- Pereg specialty flavorings: Grilled Chicken Spice, Lemon Pepper
- Root spices: ginger (*ground*), turmeric (*ground*)
- Soup mixes: consommé (chicken, beef, vegetable), Goodman's Onion Soup Mix

FRUITS WITH HASHGACHAH

- Blueberries, cranberries, strawberries

MEAT, POULTRY, & FISH

MEAT & POULTRY: Many stores have their Pesach shelves stocked from Purim, and many butchers *kasher* their meat departments after Purim. If you'd like to purchase earlier, ask your butcher for a sealed case straight from the manufacturer (as long as it's not ground or pickled). Confirm with your butcher and your rav if fresh chicken or meat in its original case is kosher for Pesach year-round.

PRE-PESACH FINAL CHECKLIST

- Wash car (*remove chametz; vacuum seats /booster seats; cup holders; trunk*)
- Check suitcases for *chametz* (*inside pockets, carry-ons, kids' backpacks*)
- Change vacuum bag (*or empty canister /clean filters if bagless*)
- Sell *chametz* (*mechiras chametz arranged with your rav; form submitted*)
- Bechers* / *Kiddush* cups: *kasher* as required (*hagalah / iruy*) or set aside Pesach-only, per your rav and material / *minhag*
- Hagalah* as needed
- Wash garbage cans (*kitchen & outdoor bins; replace liners*)
